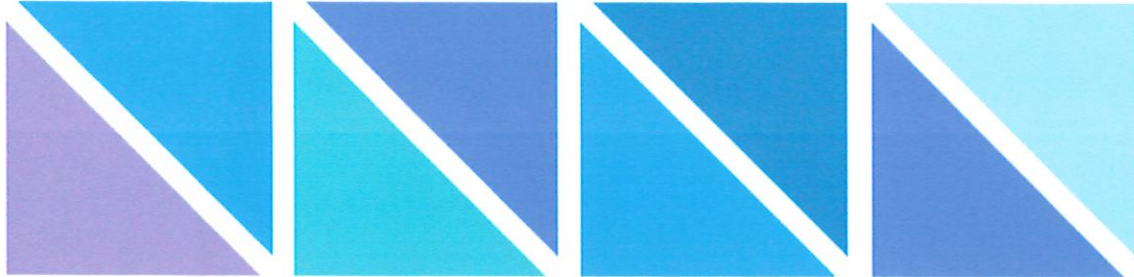

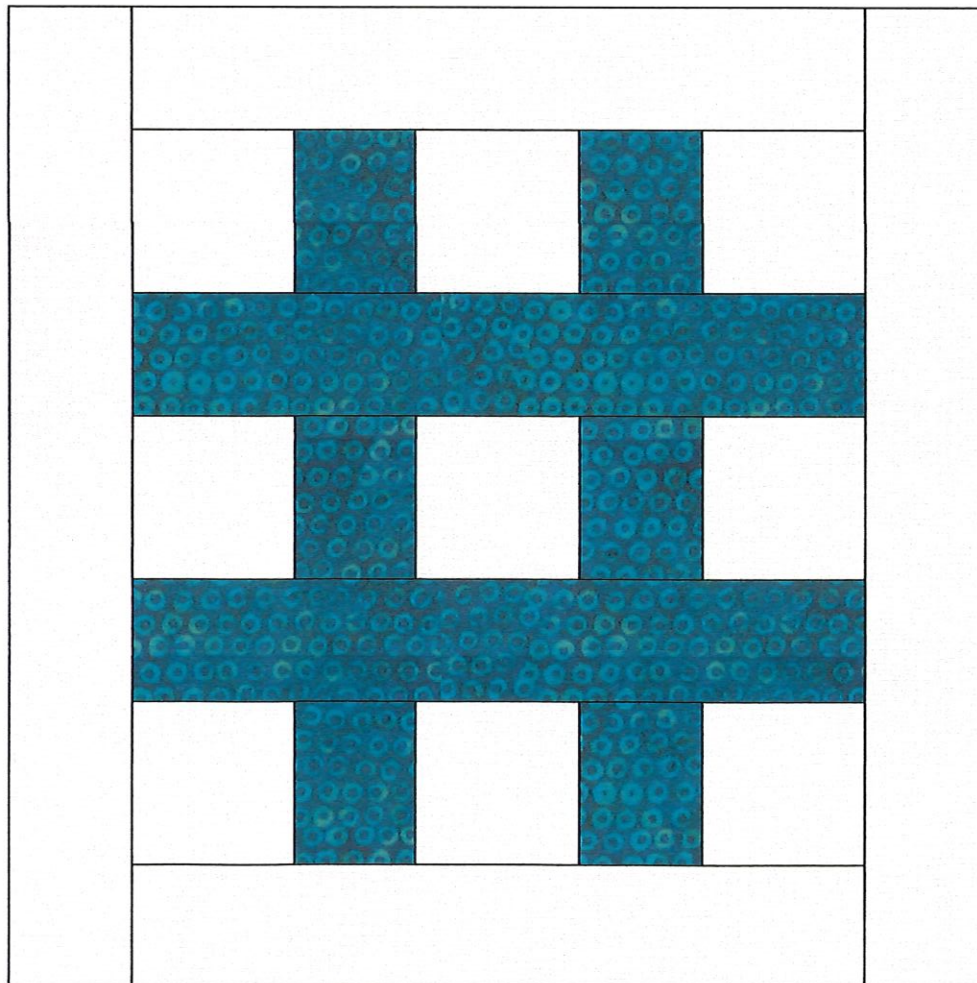

Block #11 - Hashtag Block

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



Welcome to The 50 Blocks in 50 Weeks Quilt Along with Sparrow Quilt Co! Each week we will release a new block featuring Painter's Palette Solids by Paintbrush Studio. You can find video tutorials on our website at sparrowquiltco.com and on The Sparrow Quilt Co Youtube channel.

Below, you will find cutting and piecing instructions for a single Hashtag Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

Teal - 2 inch X WOF strip

White - 5 inch X WOF strip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Teal - Cut 2 rectangles 2 X 9.5 inches. Cut another 2 rectangles 2 X 8 inches.

White Fabric - Cut 1 strip 2 X WOF. Cut second strip 2.5 X WOF.

Subcut the 2 inch strip - 2 rectangles 2 X 12.5 inch, 1 rectangle 2 X 9.5 inches.

Subcut the 2.5 inch strip - 3 rectangles 2.5 X 8 inches. Lastly, trim strip down to cut a second rectangle, 2 X 9.5 inches.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

For this block, I used a strip piecing method. To begin, you will need a white 2.5 X 8 inch rectangle and a Teal rectangle 2 X 8 inch. Piece these together on the long side. (Diagram 1.) Make two of these units and join them to each other. (Diagram 2.) Next add a third white 2.5 X 8 inch rectangle. (Diagram 3.)

Press all seams toward the teal fabric. Trim the first edge of the strip set to square the strips. You will cut 3 rectangles 2.5 inch X 9.5. (Diagram 4)

Piece one of the strip sets to a Teal 2 X 9.5 inch rectangle. Make two. Reference the block diagram for placement and join those two units to each other. Finish by adding the last strip set to the bottom of those units. This will complete the centre of the block. To finish it off, add the top and bottom 2 X 9.5 inch white rectangles; followed by the side white 2 X 12.5 inch rectangles.

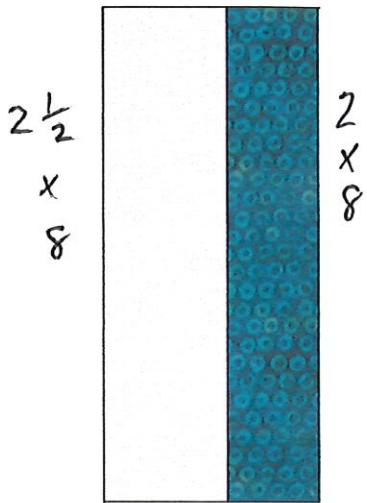


Diagram 1 *make 2 sets* →

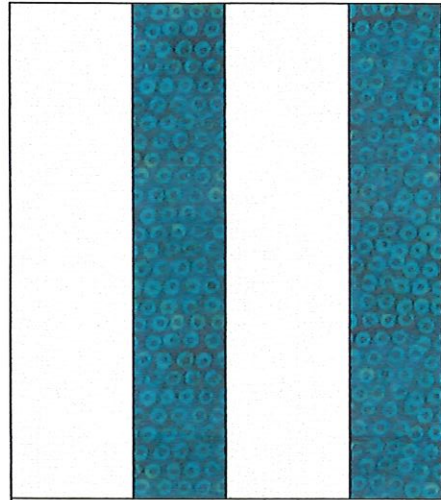

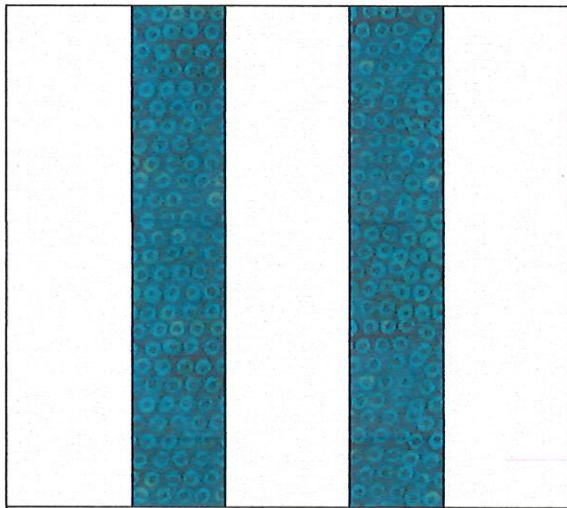


Diagram 3 *Add 2 1/2 x 8* ↑
