



Block #13 - Candy Wrapper Block

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



Welcome to The 50 Blocks in 50 Weeks Quilt Along with Sparrow Quilt Co! Each week we will release a new block featuring Painter's Palette Solids by Paintbrush Studio. You can find video tutorials on our website at sparrowquiltco.com and on The Sparrow Quilt Co Youtube channel.

Below, you will find cutting and piecing instructions for a single Candy Wrapper Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

White - 6 inch X WOF strip Raspberry - 4 X 15 inch strip Agua - 4 X 15 inch strip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

White - Cut a 2.5 inch strip and a 3.5 inch strip.

Starting with the 2.5 inch strip, cut the following:

2 rectangles - 2.5 X 8.5 inches.

2 rectangles 2.5 X 5.5 inches,

and lastly 2 rectangles 2.5 X 3.5 inches.

From the 3.5 inch strip cut 2 rectangles 3.5 X 7.5 inches.

Also cut two squares 2 7/8 X 2 7/8, then cut each once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles.

Raspberry - Cut one square 3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal to yield 2 triangles.


Cut two square 2 7/8 X 2 7/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles. YOU WILL ONLY USE 3 OF THESE.


Aqua - Cut one square 3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal to yield 2 triangles.


Cut two square 2 7/8 X 2 7/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles. YOU WILL ONLY USE 3 OF THESE.


Candy Wrapper Block

Piecing Instructions

First, let's make all your half square triangles.

Use the Pink & Aqua 3 7/8 inch triangles to create 2 squares. Trim to 3.5. (Diagram #1)

Use the Pink & Aqua 2 7/8 inch triangles to create 1 square. Trim to 2.5 inch. (Diagram #2)

Use Pink & White 2 7/8 inch triangles to create 2 squares. (Diagram #3)

Use Aqua & White 2 7/8 inch triangles to create 2 squares. (Diagram #4)

Now that all your building blocks are built, use the block diagram on front page to lay out your pieces as shown. Stitch each row together, then join the rows.

Aaaaaaand you are done another block! You deserve a treat... that was a lot of piecing. ;) <3 <3 Bradie :)
