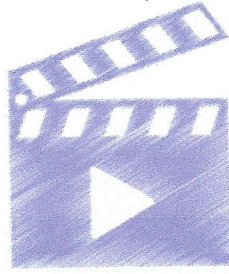
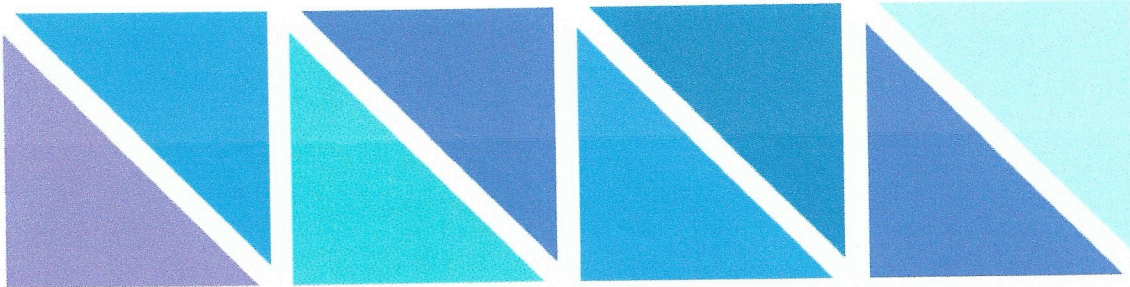

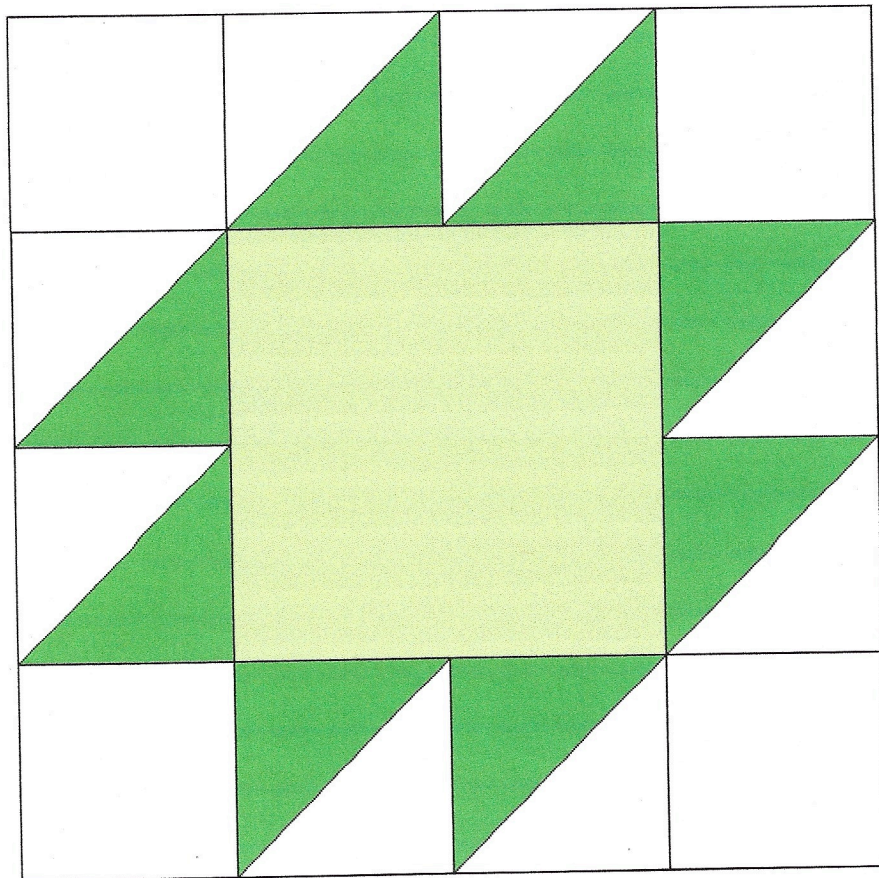

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



Welcome to The 50 Blocks in 50 Weeks Quilt Along with Sparrow Quilt Co! Each week we will release a new block featuring Painter's Palette Solids by Paintbrush Studio. You can find video tutorials on our website at sparrowquiltco.com and on The Sparrow Quilt Co Youtube channel.

Below, you will find cutting and piecing instructions for a single Buzzed Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing. WOF is Width of Fabric. Typical Quilting Fabric is 43/44 inches wide.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

Lime Mist - 6 1/2 X 6 1/2 inch square

Paradise - 4 X 16 inch strip

White - 4 X WOF strip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Lime - 6 1/2 X 6 1/2 inch square

Paradise - Cut 4 squares 3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches. Cut all once on diagonal to create 8 triangles.

White - Cut 4 squares 3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches. Cut all once on diagonal to create 8 triangles.

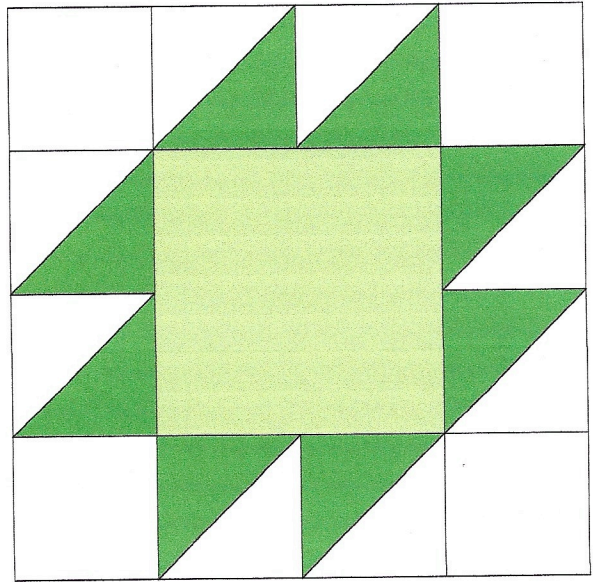
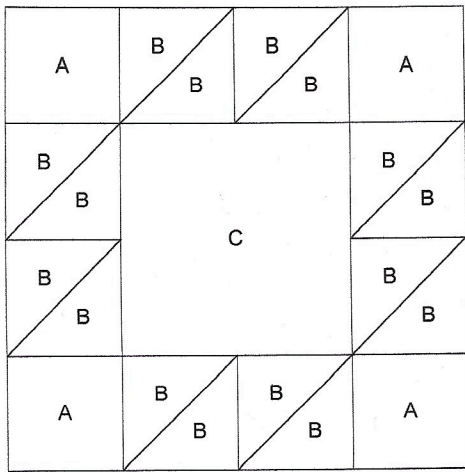
Cut 4 squares 3 1/2 X 3 1/2 inches.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

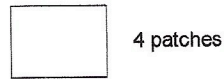
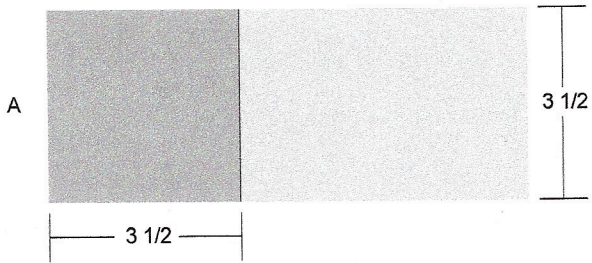
Use the white and lime triangles to create 8 Half Square Triangles. Press toward green fabric. Layout block as shown in diagram and stitch together!

Key Block (1/5 actual size)

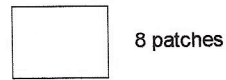
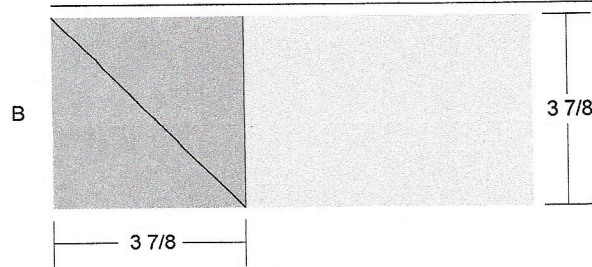


Cutting Diagrams

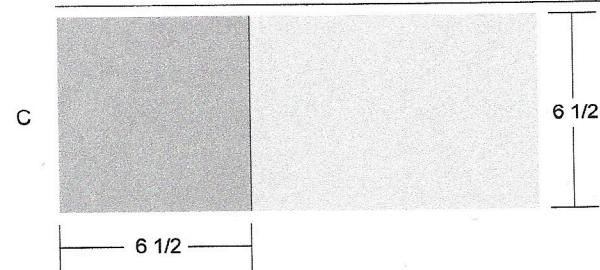


Patch Count

= final $3\frac{1}{2}$

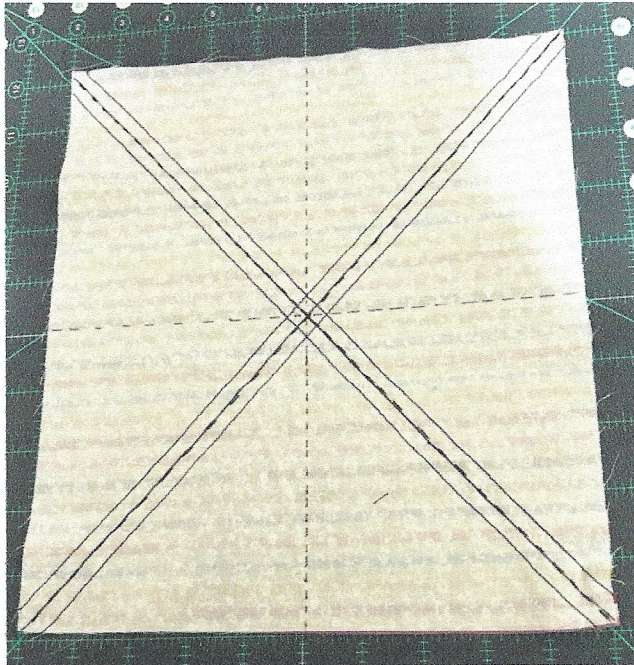


(1) $6\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

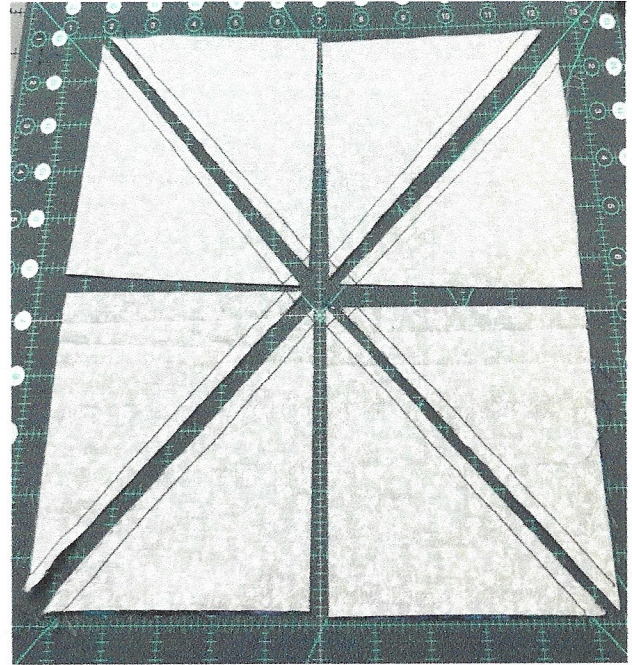
8 at a Time Half Square Triangles

For this project take two (2) 10" squares. Mark diagonal lines to the square and sew a ¼ (quarter) inch from each side of that drawn line. (Example A)

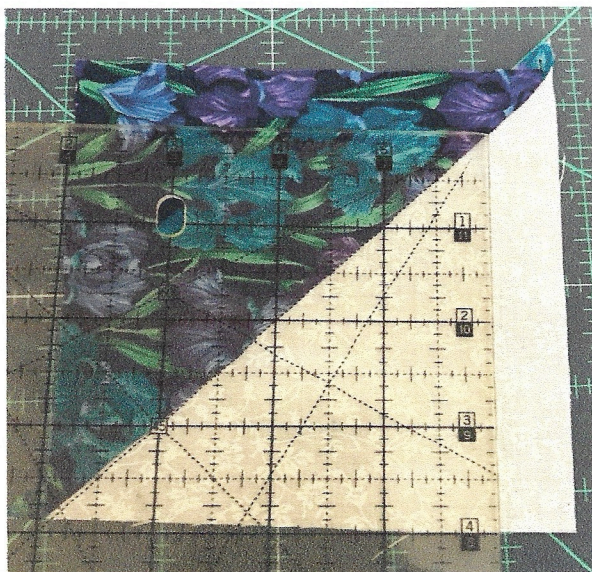

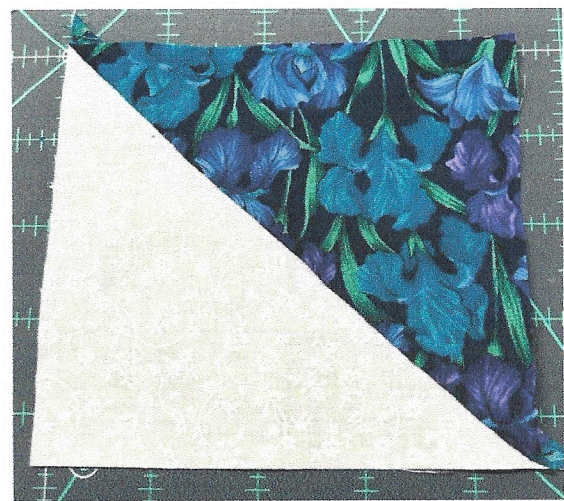
Example B



I drew dashes after sewing 1/4" where to cut. Cut down centers where I marked dashes then on diagonal lines (Example B). This gives you 8 pieces.



Trim to 3 ½ x 3 ½



There will be 8 half sq triangles
