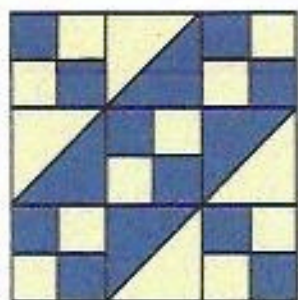




Jacob's Ladder Quilt Block

Unfinished size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Cutting Instructions:

	One Block
Print 	2 - 4 3/8" squares (A) 2 - 2 1/2" x 15" rectangles (B)
Background 	2 - 4 3/8" squares (C) 2 - 2 1/2" x 15" rectangles (D)

Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance and press as shown by arrows.

Block Assembly:

Assemble one Fabric B rectangle and one Fabric D rectangle.
Strip Set should measure 4 1/2" x 15".



Subcut each Strip Set into five 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
Partial Four Patch Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Assemble two Partial Four Patch Units.
Four Patch Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Jacob's Ladder Quilt Block

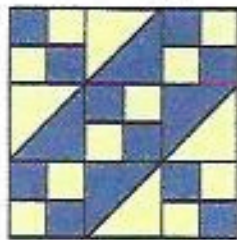
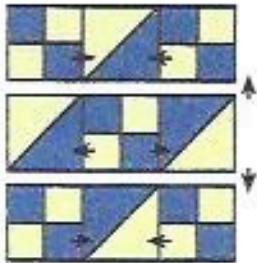
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Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square with a Fabric A square.
Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.
Cut apart on the marked line.
Half Square Triangle Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four.

Assemble the Jacob's Ladder Block.
Jacob's Ladder Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



(HST)

Half Square Triangles
4 at a time

6x6 of each color
Sew RST (Right Sides Together)

Cut on the diagonal
press, trim makes
 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Four Patch

2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 30 - RST
Sew, press & cut, join
into (5) 4 Patches
