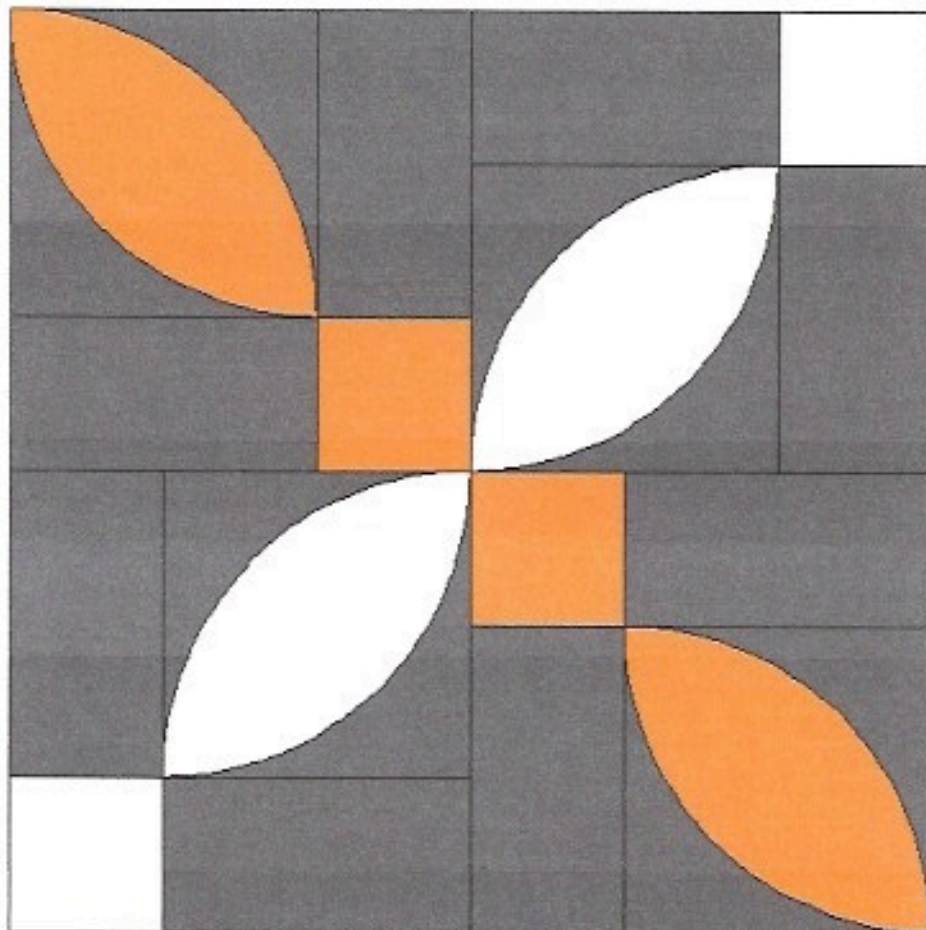

Block #21 - Candlestick Block

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



Welcome to The 50 Blocks in 50 Weeks Quilt Along with Sparrow Quilt Co! Each week we will release a new block featuring Painter's Palette Solids by Paintbrush Studio. You can find video tutorials on our website at sparrowquiltco.com and on The Sparrow Quilt Co Youtube channel.

Below, you will find cutting and piecing instructions for a single Candlestick Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing. WOF is Width of Fabric. Typical Quilting Fabric is 43/44 inches wide.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

Orange - 12 X 5 inch piece
Grey - 5 X 40 inch strip
White - 12 X 5 inch piece
Paper Backed Fusible Web 5 X 20 inch piece

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Orange - Cut 2 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ X $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
Cut two more squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Grey - Cut 4 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ X $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
Cut 8 Rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches

White - Cut 2 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ X $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
Cut two more squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

(4) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
(8) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$
(11) $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Stitch a Grey rectangle to the side of a grey square. We will need the piecing line to align our appliqué a bit later. Diagram 1.

Stitch another grey rectangle to each small orange square. Diagram 2.
 Repeat with grey rectangle and white squares.
 Stitch these two units to each other to make a larger pieced square.
 Diagram 3.

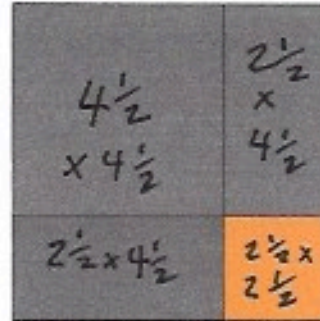

Now let's make the fusible appliqué. You will find a melon shaped template on the last page of this pattern. Trace the inner line of this shape onto the paper side of your fusible web four times, leave about half inch space between each. Using paper scissors, cut out the shapes with approximately an 1/8 inch extra buffer around each shape. Use the silk setting on your iron and press onto the wrong side of the orange and white 4 1/2 inch squares. Cut out the melon shape, 2 orange and 2 white. Next you will peel off the paper and place the tip of the melon, fabric side up, on the right side of the pieced grey units. Keep the opposite tip of the melon shape lined up with the outer corner of the pieced block. Diagram 4. Press carefully onto grey block. Make two orange and two white. Stitch around outer edge of melon shape with a tight zig zag stitch.

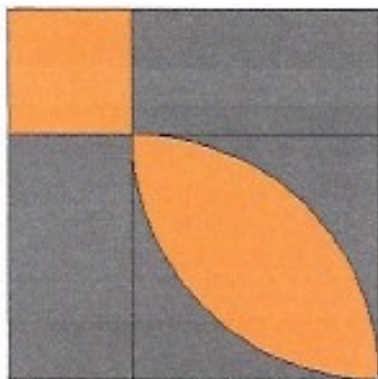
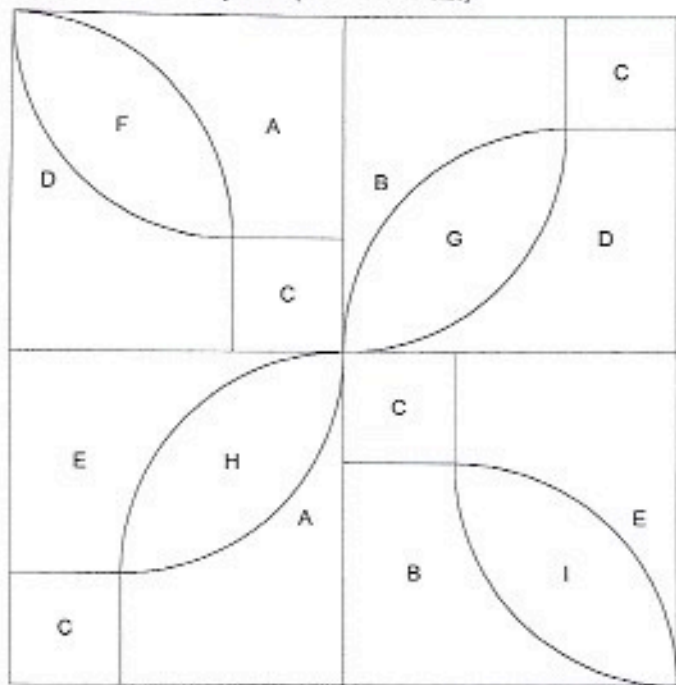

Lastly use diagram from front page to layout the four corners of the block. Piece together in pairs then join the pairs to finish the block.

Key Block (28/100 actual size)



$$C = 2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \quad (4)$$

$$D = 2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$$

$$E = 2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$$

$$A = 4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$$

$$B = 4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$$
